

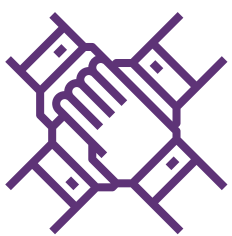

2009

The Partnership is Formed

BCT and BCPRA begin working together to integrate BCT's patient data into the PROMIS database with the goal of developing full PROMIS support for transplant care.



2011

Transplant Referrals Go Paperless!

A paperless, online kidney transplant referral system is introduced- a huge step forward from the standard paper-based system.



2011

First Joint BC Kidney Days Conference

An annual event that builds relationships across teams and provides an opportunity for sharing knowledge about innovations and advancements across the kidney care continuum.



2012

A New Funding Model

BCT implements an activity-based funding model for the renal transplant group. As with BCPRA's funding model, it follows the patient as he or she moves through the system.



2014

Living Donation Booklets Hit the Shelves

BCT and BCPRA publish a set of three booklets, "Finding a Donor", "The Kidney Transplant Process", and "The Living Donor Kidney Transplant Process" for patients and living donors. The booklets were distributed to kidney and transplant clinics across the province.



2017

Transplant First

BCPRA and BCT launch "Transplant First," a joint initiative to promote pre-emptive transplants and improve quality of life and health outcomes for patients with advanced kidney disease.
