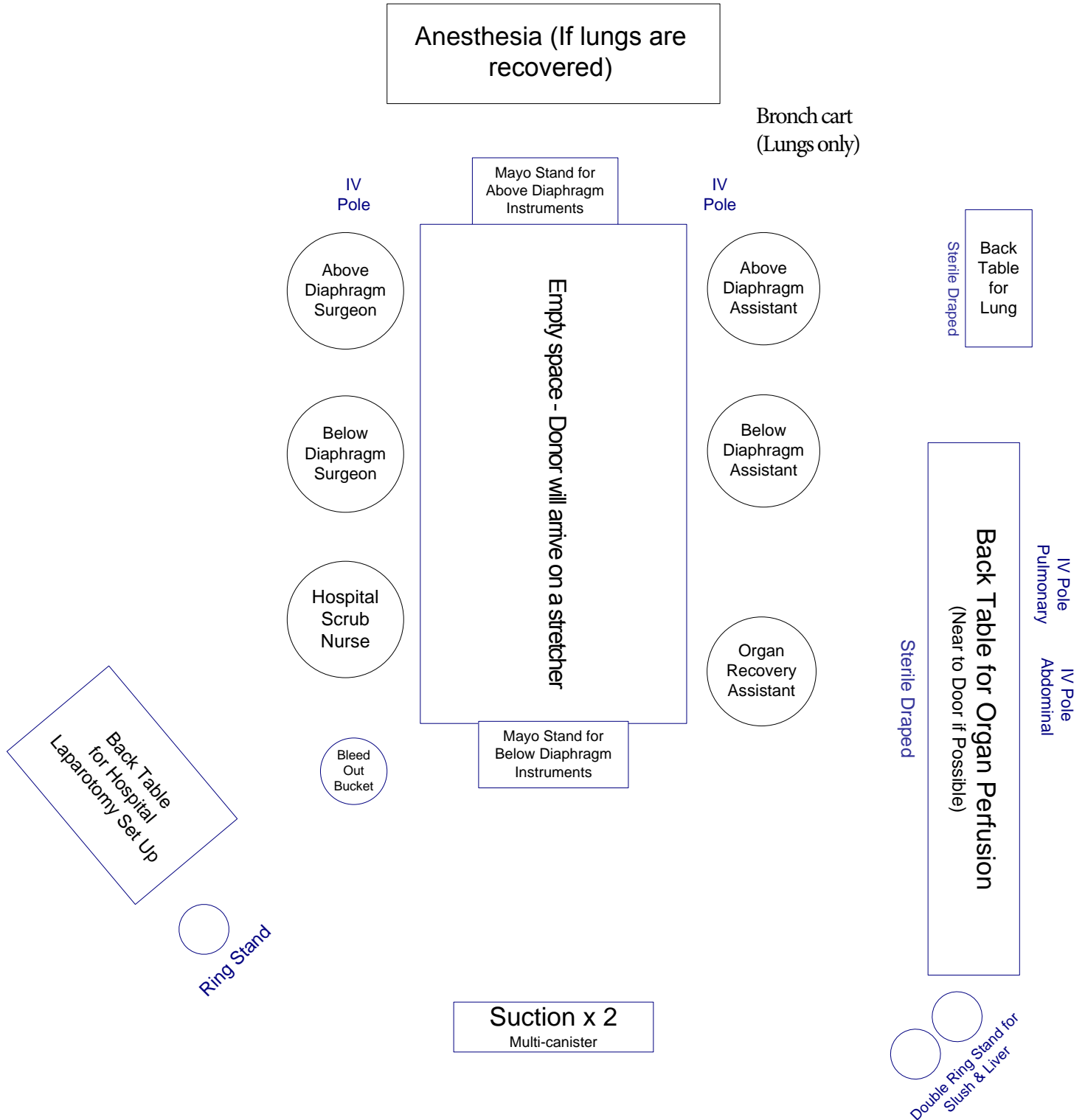


Operating Room Set Up - DCD



Procedure: Organ Recovery – Single or Multi-Organ - DCD

Skin Prep:

Solution as per hospital protocol. Prep from chin to mid-thigh, bedline to bedline.

Draping:

Laparotomy drapes are acceptable with a wider area of exposure. Free draping is also acceptable and may be preferred.

Position of Patient:

Supine with arms tucked in at the sides.

Instruments and Equipment

To be added to the basic Laparotomy set up:

Back Tables:

- 1 for Instruments
- 1 for Organ Perfusion
- 1 for Lung Team –if needed

Single Basins:

- 2 Single Basins in ring stands
- 1 for Perfusion Table
- 1 for Lung Perfusion Table (if recovering lungs)

Mayo Stands:

- 1 for BCT Below Diaphragm Instruments
- 1 for BCT Above Diaphragm Instruments
- Suction Units x 2
- Extra IV Poles -- 1 x Above Diaphragm
--1 x Below Diaphragm
- Bleedout Bucket

Other:

- Medium Clip Applicators and Bars
- Large Lap Sponges
- Asepto Syringe
- Large Ortho Mallet
- Silk Ties (2 silk, 2-0 Silk, 3-0 Silk) as requested
- Scrub Gowns - up to 6
- Extra Grad Jug
- Scalpel Blades x 2

If recovering lungs:

- Equipment for intubation (laryngoscope, #8 ETT, ventilator)
- Instruments for Tracheostomy (#8 cuffed tracheostomy tube, tracheal hook) - Outside room
- Flexible Bronchoscope with sputum trap

Buckets of Ice needed at end of case.
