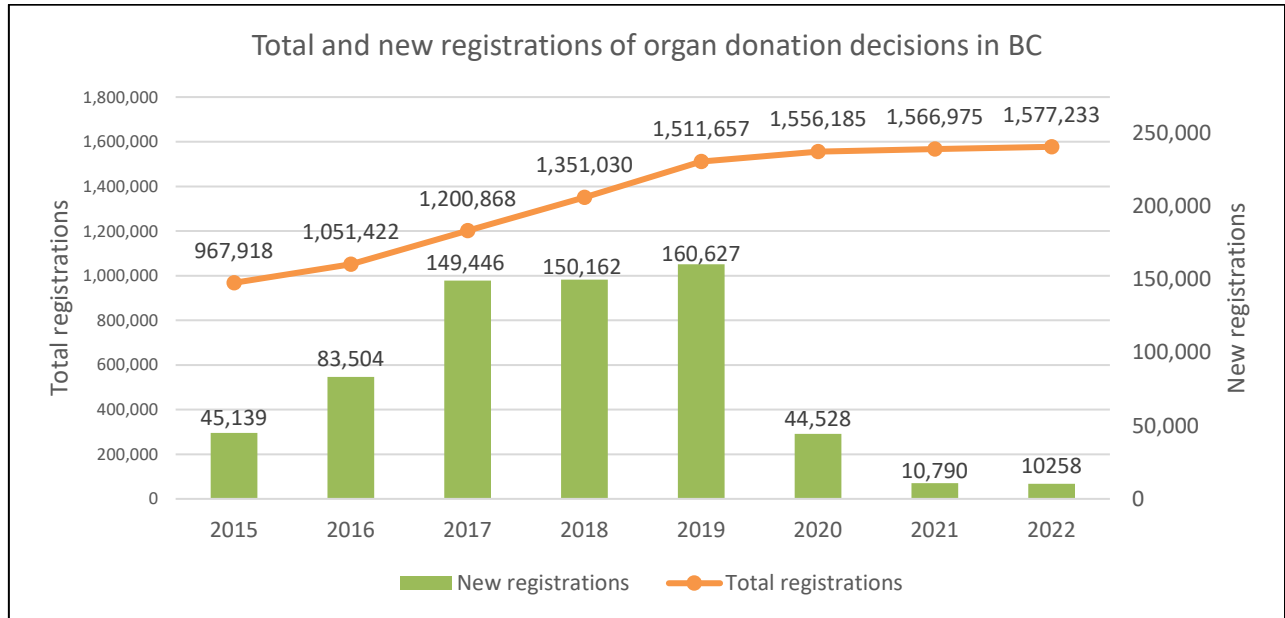


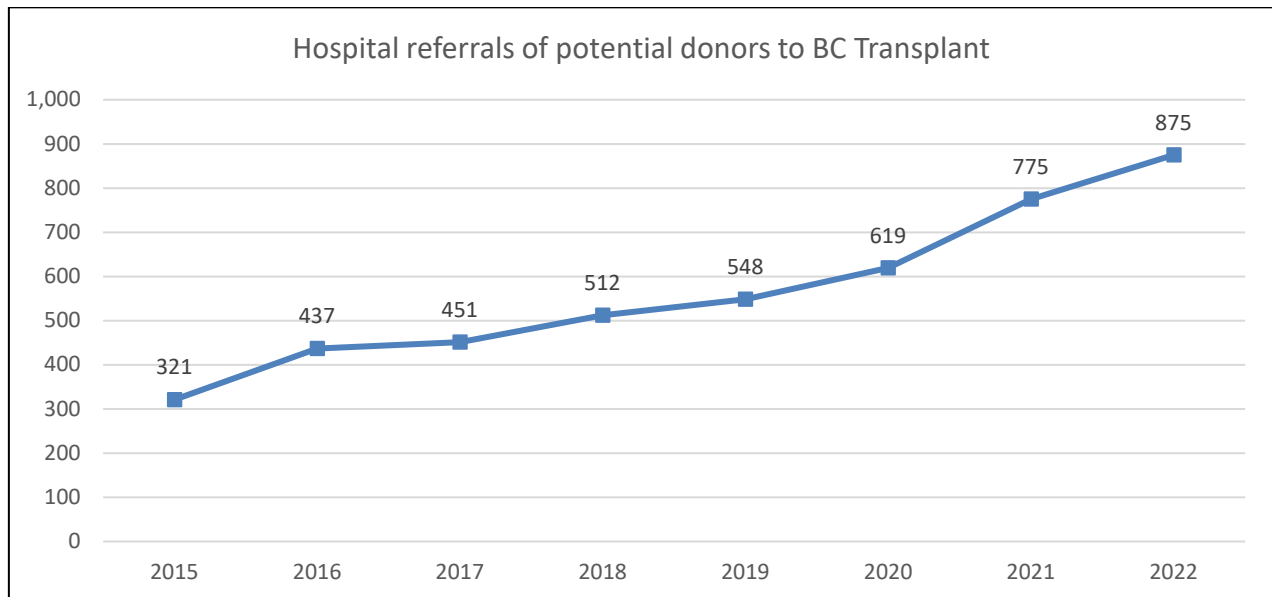
1. Total and new registrations of organ donation decisions in British Columbia

2. Hospital referrals of potential deceased donors to BC Transplant

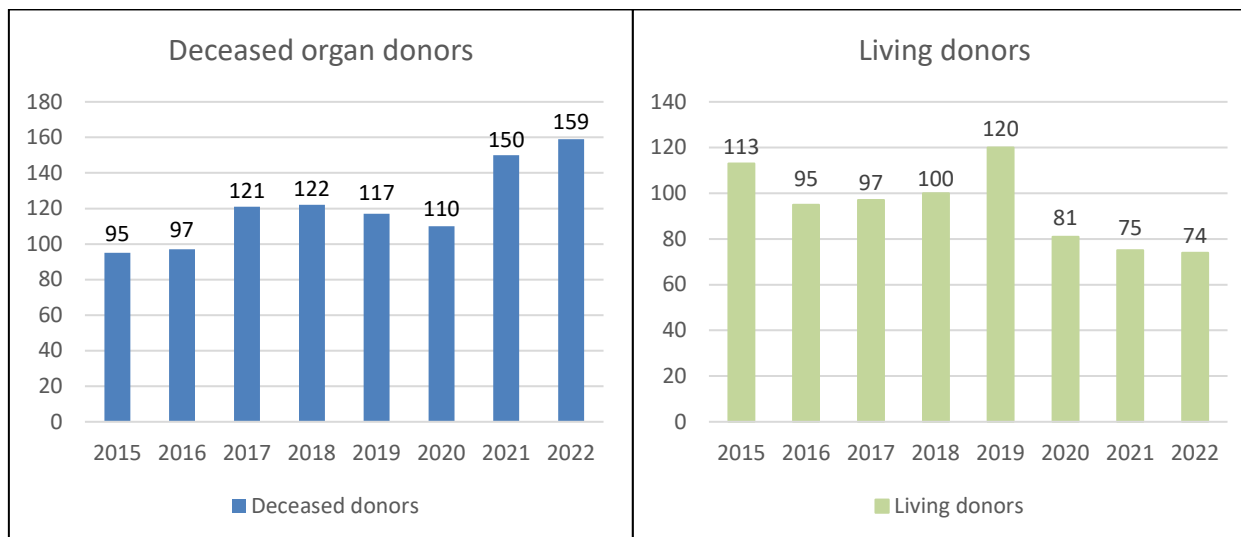

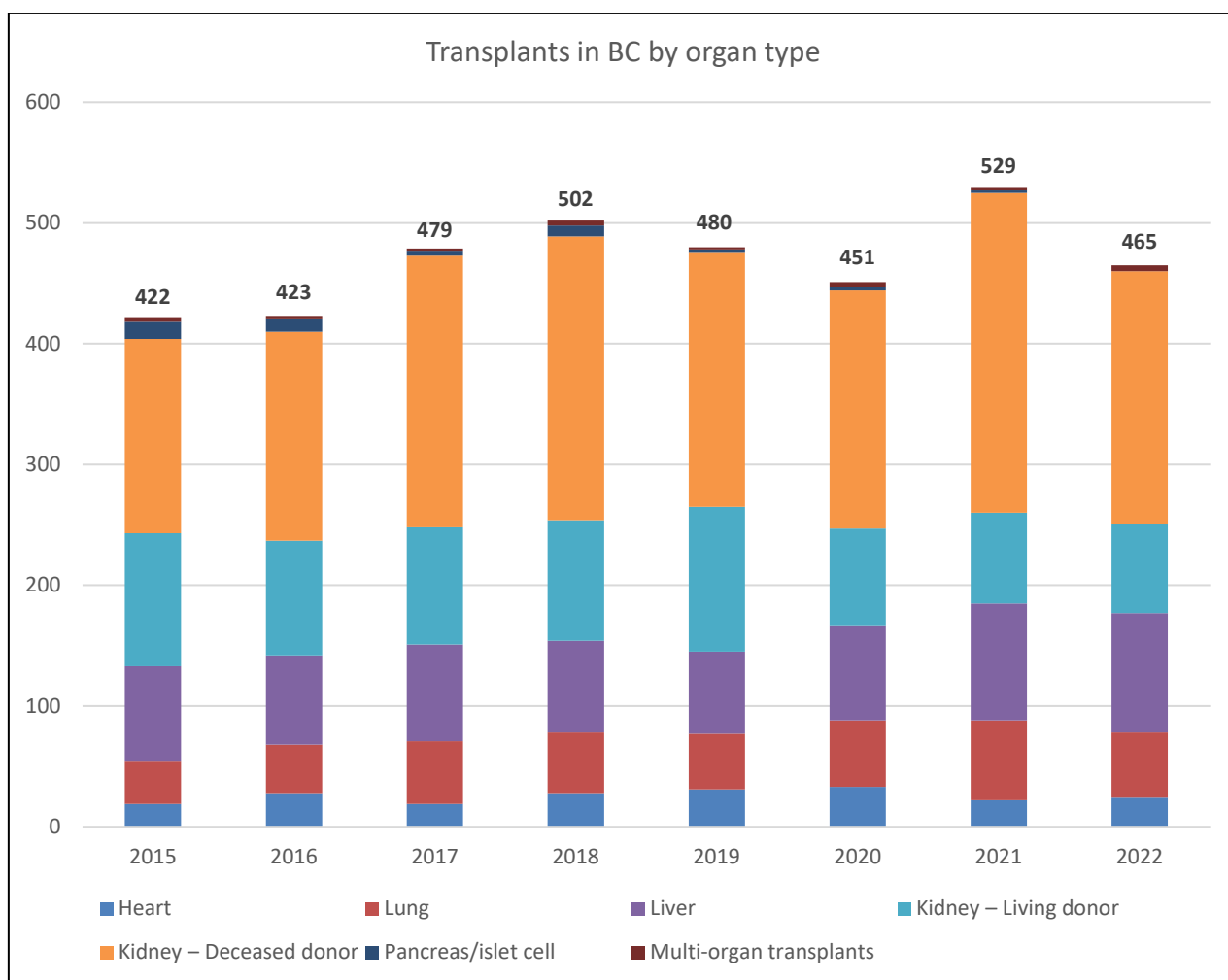

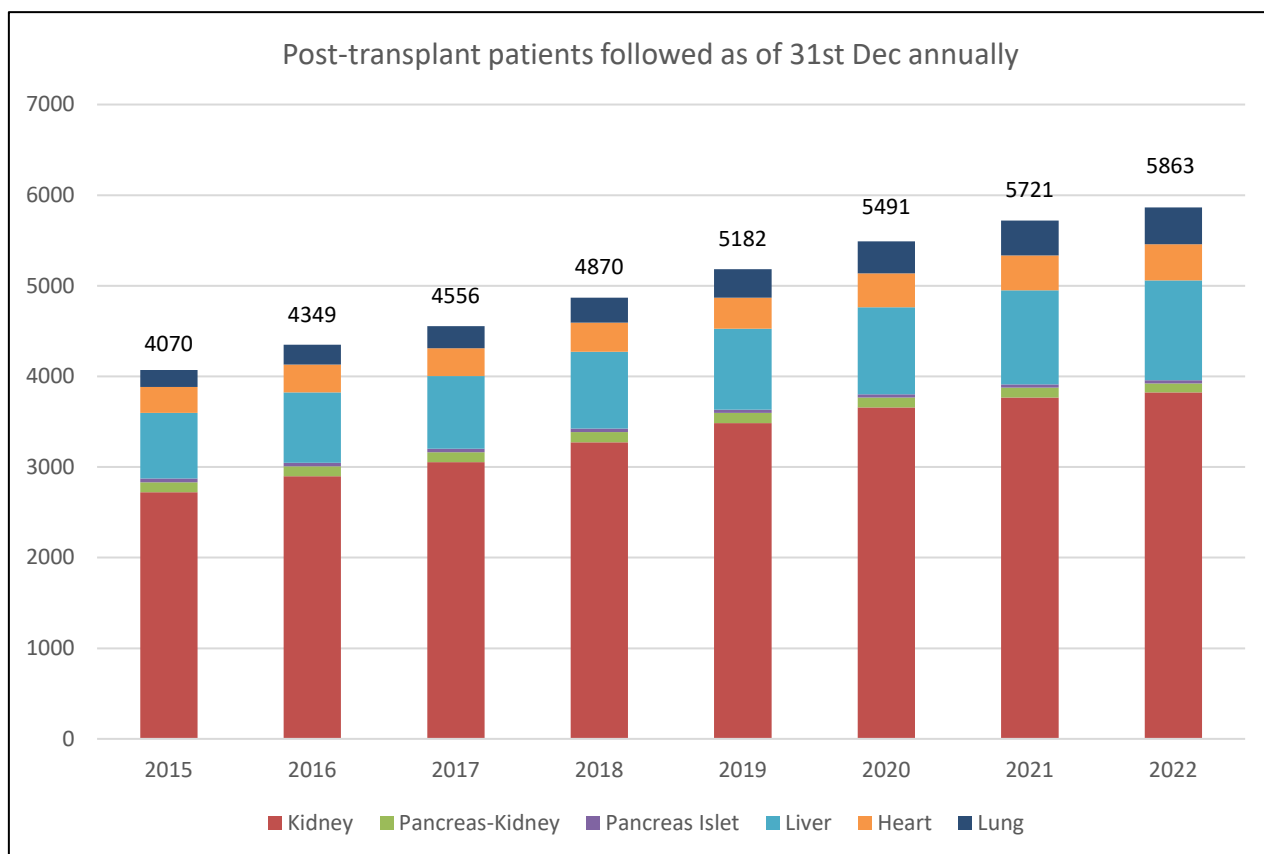
